Work Restrictions:


Memorial Day and Labor Day Weekends – No work will be allowed on the preceding Friday and all-day Saturday.

Reverse Osmosis Unit at the UI Water Plant Rick Ney – Director, Energy Delivery - Engie

UI Water Plant will begin operating a new Reverse Osmosis unit on June 1, 2021

UI drinking water will then be a 50-50 blend of water from our traditional treatment processes and water filtered through the RO unit

The process was installed with the primary goal of enhancing the plant's ability to remove nitrates from the water supply

The process will result in the campus seeing water with lower conductivity (lower suspended solids)

For those departments who further purify our water for medical or laboratory needs, this could mean a change in your local treatment needs, but the good news is that it should reduce the amount of treatment required

Business Continuity is...

- Continuity of critical functions following an incident that overwhelms normal everyday operations
- Separate but complimentary to disaster recovery and emergency preparedness
- Big picture with some details
- Documented prior to disaster to ensure UI can continue critical functions necessary to meet mission

- The recovery of vital technology infrastructure and systems following natural or human-induced disaster
- Focuses on IT supporting critical functions & recovery procedures
- Can be considered subset of business continuity
