





Timeline Integrating community review and feedback

- →30 Day Plan
 - June is dedicated to supporting the Return to Campus Pilot Programs, learning and planning. Engage with Return to Campus work flow process.
- →60 Day Plan
 - July is dedicated to implementation, preparation and testing
 - By early August, adjust and test
 - Assist with Unit Plans as needed
- → 120 Day Plan
 - August and September support fall semester start
 - Monitor, adjust as needed
