Supply Chain Issues

- Demand is greater than supply
- Vendors coming into market – unvetted and fraudulent
- Supply costs have increased 200-300%
 - N95 masks pre-covid19 \$.50 – Market \$2.50-\$5.99
 - 3 ply masks – Pre-Covid19 \$.20 – Market \$.75-1.50+ (even with contracted vendors)
- **Emergency catalog prices:**
 - N95 Honeywell – small supply from the state = **FREE**
 - 3 ply masks - \$.32 each
 - **We are buying in bulk centrally to control costs**
 - **FEMA eligible so we need to keep the costs reasonable**

Employee Return to Work Kits

→ Employee Return to work kits – paid for centrally

- 2 disposable
- 1 face shield
- Hand sanitizer
